- 1984 Spain: co-wrote songs with Denny Laine (Wings/Moody Blues) for "Spreading my Wings"/Denny Laine/ Prestige Records. Played in several bands in Spain and London.
- 1985 Tuscany: Secured a publishing contract with Filmtrax Plc in London, and composed 15 documentary soundtracks for RAI Television, Italy. Studied film music composition with Ennio Morricone.
- 1986 Rome: Worked for the BMG Ariola soundtrack library, in Rome, reporting to the CEO, Mario Cantini.
- 1988 Egypt, Namibia, Qatar, Bahrain, UAE. and Oman: Business development consultant with Government Ministers on behalf of EOS Audiovideo for film projects.
- 1989 Florence/ Rome: Co-founder and joint CEO, Amiata Media record label. Developed the brand, artist roster and worldwide distribution network. Produced a number of records for the Amiata label, including "Naked Spirit" (Sainkho Namtchylak), which won the Schalplatten Prize for best world music album in 1998. Produced music for Synaulia and the Fratelli Mancuso, tracks from these artists were featured in the movies, "Gladiator" and "The Talented Mr. Ripley".
